

My Father's House Haiti








Haiti is the poorest country in Latin America and the Caribbean, and one of the poorest in the world

1. More than 6 million Haitians live below the poverty line on less than \$2.00 a day, and more than 2.5 million live in extreme poverty.
2. Poverty mainly affects women and young people. Street children in Haiti are one of the most vulnerable groups exposed to violence, abuse and gangs. They live in shame, without affection, without food, without guidance and care.
3. Most boys will do odd jobs to survive, while the girls are often exploited as slaves
4. They have never known a home. They will grow up on the streets of Port-au-Prince, the capital of the poorest country on the American continent.

After Those Earthquakes, The Number Of The Children Of The Orphanage Increased From 25 To 220 Orphans.

The 2010 the earthquake in Haiti had a magnitude 7.34.

The first earthquake left many dead, injured and amputees, in addition to thousands of people suffering from psychological disorders. More than 480,000 people were killed, 300,000 injured and 1.3 million homeless.

Life in Haiti is extremely difficult, so we are dedicated to helping the orphans. Haitian law requires children to leave the orphanage once they turn 20.

To address this, we have built a vocational school to provide these children with skills before they leave. Many children have already benefited from this program.

Furthermore, we have also set up a primary school within the same building to provide education to children in the surrounding area.

We still need to build dormitories to properly care for the children.




